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# The Payment of Bonus Rules, 1975<sup>1</sup>

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 38 of the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 (21 of 1965), and in supersession of the Payment of Bonus Rules, 1965 the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

- **1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Payment of Bonus Rules, 1975.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Definition.-In this rules-
  - (a) "form" means a form appended to these rules;
  - (b) 'Act" means as the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 (21 of 1965):
  - (c) "Section" means a section of the Act.
- **3. Authority for granting permission for change of accounting year.**-The prescribed authority for the purposes of the proviso to paragraph (b) of sub-clause (iii) of clause (1) of Section 2 shall be-
  - (a) in the case of an establishment in relation to which the Central Government is the appropriate Government under the Act, the Chief Labour Commissioner (Central);
  - (b) in any other case, the Labour Commissioner of the State in which the establishment is situated.
- **4. Maintenance of registers.-**Every employer shall prepare and maintain the following registers, namely-
  - (a) a register showing the computation of the allocable surplus referred to in clause (4) of Section 2, in Form A;
  - (b) a register showing the set on and set-off of the allocable surplus under Section 15, in Form B;
  - (c) a register showing the details of the amount of bonus due to each of the employees, the deduction under Sections 17 and 18 and the amount actually disbursed, in Form C.
- <sup>2</sup>[5. Annual Returns. (1) Every employer shall on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February in each year upload annual returns in the Form D on the web portal of the Ministry of Labour and Employment giving information as to the particulars specified in respect of the preceding year:—

Provided that the annual returns shall be filed within the time limit specified in section 19 of the Act.

(2) Every employer on or before the 1st day of February in each year may file annual returns in the Form D to the Inspector giving information as to the particulars specified in respect of the preceding year:

Provided that during inspection, the inspector shall require the production of the accounts, books, register and other documents if the same are maintained in manual form or in electronic form, as the case may be.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 (21 of 1965) (hereinafter referred to as the `said Act') and in continuation of Government Notification, Industries, Energy and Labour Department No. PBA.1098/ (6696)/Lab-9, dated the 16<sup>th</sup> April 2001, the Government of Maharashtra, hereby appoints the following officers mentioned in column (2) of the Scheduled appended hereto, to be duly qualified Inspectors, for the purpose of the said Act, and assigned them jurisdiction over the areas respectively specified against each of them in column (3) of Schedule.

Provided that the Commissioner of Labour, Mumbai, Maharashtra State, who is authorised under the said section vide Government Notification No.PBA 1085/10764/Lab-5, dated the 8<sup>th</sup> November, 1985 shall not exercise the powers conferred on him in respect of all areas of the Special Economic Zones in State of Maharashtra.

## Notification No.PBA.010/2001(7272)/LAB-9 dated the 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 30 of the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 (21 of 1965) (hereinafter referred to as the `said Act') and in continuation of Government Notification, Industries, Energy and Labour Department No. PBA. 1685/10740/Lab-5, dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> August 1985, the Government of Maharashtra being the appropriate Government hereby, specially authorises the Development Commissioner, Special Economic Zones, in the State of Maharashtra to be the authority for the purpose of the said Section in the area of Special Economic Zones:

Provided that the Commissioner of Labour, Maharashtra State, who is authorised as the authority for the purpose of the said section vide Government Notification, Industries, Energy and Labour Department, No.PBA 1685/10740/Lab-5, dated the 23rd August, 1985 shall not exercise the powers under the said section in respect of the areas of Special Economic Zone, in State of Maharashtra.

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
